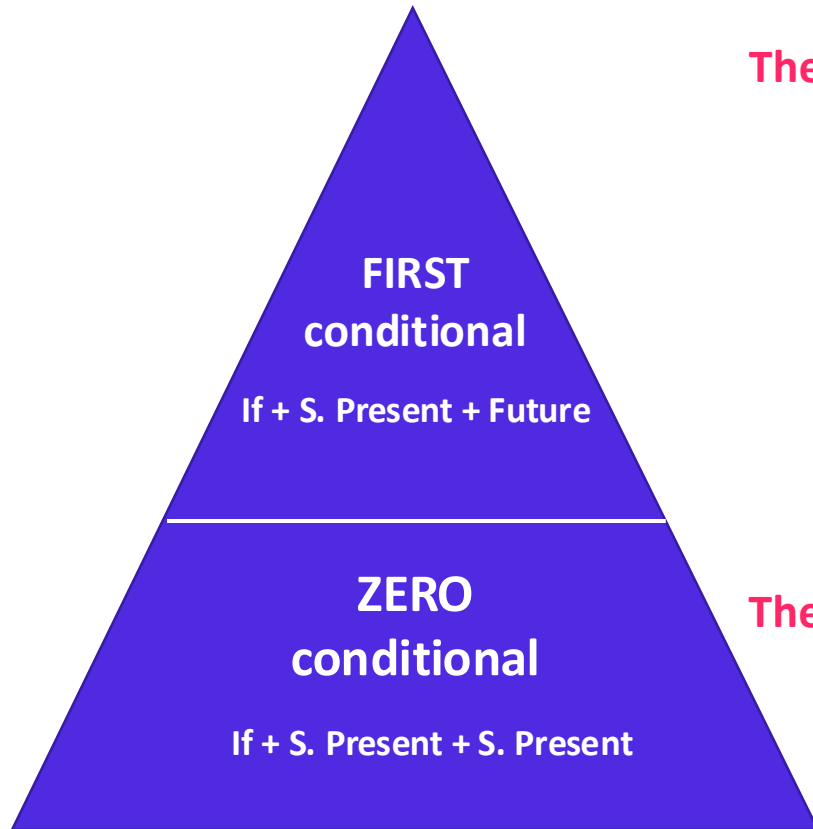
FIRST CONDITIONAL

The **first conditional** is used when we talk about **future situations we believe are real or possible.**

If we finish the project today, we **will** go home early.
We are going to buy a car If we save enough money.

The **zero conditional** is used to talk about **facts or situations that are normally or always true.**
