Adverbs of Frequency

Always	Siempre
Often	Seguido / a menudo
Usually	Usualmente
Sometimes	Algunas veces
Rarely	Rara vez
Once in a while	De vez en cuando
Never	Nunca

Adverbs of frequency placement

Subject + Adverb + Verb

I *always / often / usually / rarely / never* train in the morning

Adverbs of frequency placement

Sometimes / Once in a while + Subject + Verb

Sometimes I train in the morning

Once in a while, I train in the morning

Adverbs of frequency placement

Subject + To be + Adverb

My sister **IS **always** busy**
